Year 7&8 Workshop: Students identified their personal strengths and motivations

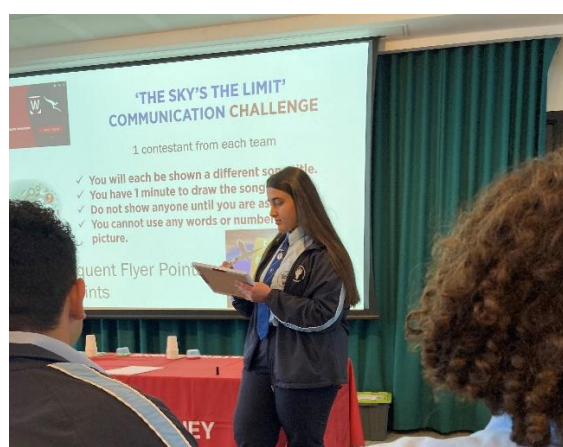
Year 9&10 Workshop: Students explored various career pathways using online tools.
